WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Please remember ----

- All children have outside large motor playtime during their day.
- The Illinois Department of Health determines a weather criterion for outside play for children.
- The minimum temperature, taking into account wind chill factor, for outdoor play at Trinity Youth Services is approximately 30 degrees.
- If your child is not well enough for outside play, they are not well enough to be at the center.
- Please remember the 5 finger rule of readiness when preparing your child for the preschool or after school club:
 1. Coat
 2. Snow Boots
 3. Hat
 4. Mittens or Gloves
 5. Snow Pants
- Please label your child's = coat, shoes, **boots, snow pants**, (as it seems everyone has black) hats, backpacks, etc.
- Kids Klub and Little Lambs Extended Care parents need to observe the same fall and winter dress preparedness on Snow Days, as we will be enjoying the snow, temperature providing.
- Kids Klub and Little Lambs Extended Care parents need to call the center by 8:00 a.m. on a snow day if they will be needing care after 8:00 a.m., as we will be dismissing unnecessary staff after that time.
