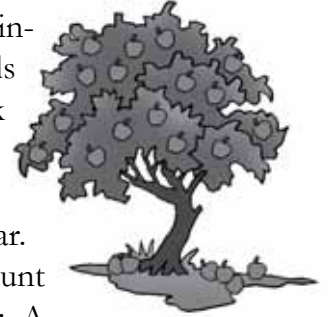
Annual Congregation Meeting

Trinity Mission Endowment and Memorial Fund

Endowment Fund

1. The next Charitable Giving Seminar will be on Sunday, February 19, 2012 from 9:15 to 10:15 a.m. in the church parlor. Please sign up by calling the church office, or fill out a registration form in the Sunday worship bulletin.



2. The Action Team has established a Trinity Mission Endowment Fund with the Lutheran Community Foundation. We will need to have available, \$25,000 in cash before we can officially open this account. When it is fully funded, we will begin to draw annual earnings on the funds, and distributions will be made to mission needs through Trinity.

Memorial Fund

In last month's issue of *The Trumpet*, we shared with you the following six memorial projects for Trinity. Memorial Fund envelopes are available at the Welcome Desk kiosk, or the church office. We will be able to accomplish these projects as you give to Trinity's Memorial Fund.

- Christian Education: \$400 needed for purchasing puppets and resources for a puppet ministry.
- Facility Needs: \$1,000 needed for installing lights to backlight the cross on the front wall of the chancel area.
- Worship: \$4,600 to make improvements and upgrades to our sound system.
- Trinity's Preschool: \$10,000 for providing a scholarship program to assist needy families with the cost of tuition.
- Outreach: \$1,000 as an "Emergency Needs Fund" for individuals and/or families from Trinity and/or in the community who need financial assistance.
- Trinity's Endowment Fund: A gift may be given into the Endowment Fund, in memory of a person. These funds are invested and only the earnings are expended.

A full report of the giving to the Trinity Mission Endowment Fund and the Memorial Fund will be included in the Trinity Annual Report.

News from the Choir

In the United States, choral singing is the most popular of all arts-related participatory activities. Across the country, 28.5 million people regularly sing in one of 250,000 chorus groups. There may be a very good reason why: Singing simply makes happy!

The act of singing releases endorphins, the brain's "feel good" chemicals. Several scientific studies have shown that especially choral singers are considerably more satisfied with their lives, have fewer anxieties and are more upbeat than the general public.

The intense and highly regular breathing required while singing is a healthy aerobic activity. Learning new songs and focusing on the task keeps the brain highly active, yet the mind off one's daily sorrows. Singing in front of a crowd builds confidence. And most importantly: choral singers tend to be happier because of their feelings of belonging to a group, of being needed by the other members of that group.

Submission Guidelines for *The Trumpet and Bulletin*

Please provide news/articles by the 10th of the month to the editor of *The Trumpet*, and to the church office for the *Bulletin* by Tuesday of any given week. Typed or hand-written articles may be brought or mailed well in advance to the church office. We prefer all submissions to be made by email, though. Send articles for *The Trumpet* to trumpet_editor@trinityonthehill.com, and for the *Bulletin* to trinityonthehill@sbcglobal.net. Please use the following guidelines for electronic files. This will enable the editor, publisher, and church secretary to do their jobs more efficiently and help to ensure *The Trumpet* and *Bulletin* are published in a timely way. Your promptness and cooperation are very much appreciated.

- **Write your article using MS Word**, or at least save as a Word document (file extension .doc) or as Rich Text Format (extension .rtf) if using WordPerfect or another word processing program. **No** Microsoft Publisher files, or PDFs, please.
- **Reduce formatting to essentials**—no tabs, columns, indentations, special fonts or arranging of text with multiple line breaks or blank spaces, please! They will all be deleted! Simple bullet lists

are acceptable but will be reformatted, so don't waste time on them. Bold and italicized fonts are acceptable, but please limit their use (no underscores or other fancy formats).

- **Do not include graphics** in the document. Send graphics as separate attachments, and if there is a preference, indicate where you want them placed.
- **Photos** may be submitted as .jpg, .tiff or .eps files. **Graphics** should be high resolution. Additional acceptable graphic formats are .gif and .png. Graphics taken from the internet usually have a low resolution and thus may result in small images in print.
- Include instructions in the document in colored type, and/or put them in the E-mail.

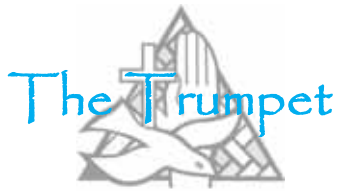
