How We Spend Our Time

MORNINGS

- BREAKFAST -- Breakfast is served at 7:30 a.m. Breakfast may consist of either cereal or a nutritious snack from home.
- ACTIVITIES -- Children have the option of engaging in a variety of table-top or floor activities or they may work on homework.
- DISMISSAL -- Children are supervised onto the school bus.

AFTERNOONS

- SNACK TIME 3:30-4:00 p.m. -- Every day after school the children receive a snack and 100% juice.
- GROUP ACTIVITY AND/OR FREE CHOICE TIME 4:00-5:00 p.m. -- After snack, children participate in two ½ hour segments of organized games, group activities or free choice.
- OPEN CHOICE/HOMEWORK 5:00-5:30 p.m. -- Children have a chance to complete homework assignments after having reenergized through social and physically engaging activities, or they may engage in quiet play with friends.
- READING/HOMEWORK TIME 5:30-6:00 p.m. -- During the last ½ hour of the day, as we all wind down, we offer children on opportunity to continue homework or engage in quiet reading or group story time.
