The curriculum is designed to aid in the growth and development of the whole child with regard to emotional, social, physical, and cognitive skills. The child is the key individual in the program. They have opportunities to build new and deeper understandings. They work with materials that stimulate and challenge thinking. The children are encouraged to investigate, ask questions, infer and generalize. They have opportunities to be self-selective and self-directive in their activities.
