Be a Prince or Princess for the week and enjoy living the life of royalty in our Magic Kingdom, where fairies and dragons are friends.

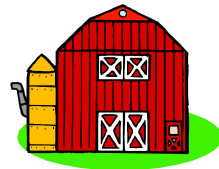


3. June 15-19 What's Cooking?

Measure, Mix and Stir. Yum, yum...I hope you've brought your appetite because this week we will be concocting some truly scrumptious edibles.

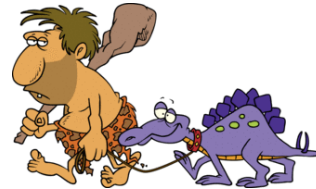
4. June 22-26 Rainforest Friends

Expectations for Campers

- ★ Children need to respect the staff, each other and the learning environment.
- ★ Must be able to exhibit group behavior and follow rules (with minimal disruption to the flow of teaching/learning).

Enrollment Standards

- ★ For children 3 years-entering 1st grade.
- ★ All children must be completely toilet trained and able to manage all personal care (bathroom) on their own with minimal verbal prompts. No pull-ups allowed.
- ★ Birth certificates are required for all new participants.
- ★ Must be able to ambulate on own.
- ★ Must be able to perform gross motor functions with verbal prompts.

Need to Know Info

- ★ Most projects and activities are enjoyed outside (weather permitting). Please provide a minimum 30 spf sunblock.
- ★ Proper camp attire is expected and necessary everyday for full program activity participation.
- ★ Proper camp attire includes, bathing suit, towel, athletic type shoes (sandals considered optional in addition to athletic shoes).
- ★ Swim suits, towels & water bottles must be brought and taken home daily.
- ★ We need a sack lunch each day, lunches can be refrigerated.
